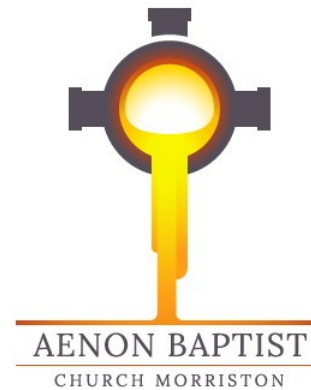

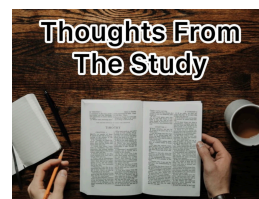

### Joshua 1:8 (Revised Standard Version)

*This book of the law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall have good success.*

If you've ever asked why it is so important to read the bible everyday, then ask also if your life reflects the teachings of Jesus in the bible?

When God was about to lead Joshua and the people out of the wilderness and into the promised land He gave Joshua one command, to meditate on the teachings of Moses '*day and night*'. 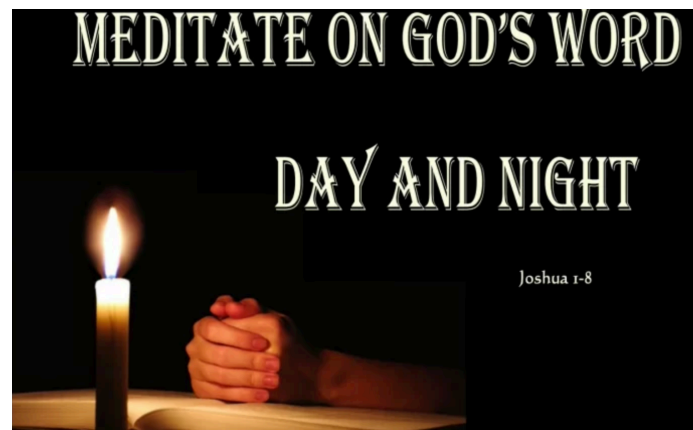

### Plastic free July

#### What is it?

Plastic Free July® is a global movement that helps millions of people be part of the solution to plastic pollution - so we can have cleaner streets, oceans, and beautiful communities. Will you be part of Plastic Free July by choosing to refuse single-use?

#### It's impact

With a remarkable 174 million participants globally in 2024, Plastic Free July now stands as the largest waste avoidance campaign on the planet, solidifying July as the global month of action against plastic pollution.

Headline results for Plastic Free July 2024 include:

- Globally, 29% of consumers (at least 316 million people) were aware of Plastic Free July
- At least 174 million people took part in the challenge
- Participants take 23% more action to reduce plastic waste
- Participants reduced their household waste by 16 kgs per person per year (3.8% less waste)
- More than 75% of the population supports policies and action to reduce waste
- Participants have strong social connections and a positive sense of well-being



## ECO-CHURCH (Continued ...)

An astonishing 10 billion kgs of household waste has been avoided by participants over the last five year because millions of people choose to make a change for cleaner streets, healthy oceans, and beautiful communities or just to do the right thing.

So, how to join in...

Choose one single-use plastic to avoid or take the pledge to avoid single-use cups, plastic drink bottles, or plastic food wrap.

These "Top 3" items are single-use plastic items we commonly use each day that most of us can be easily replaced by:

- Refilling reusable water bottles from the tap
- Using a reusable coffee cup or sitting and enjoy a real cup
- Switching from plastic wrap to reusable containers or wax wraps.

Why not keep your bottle and cup in the car so you always have it with you when you need it?

You can officially join and make your pledge by registering at [plasticfreejuly.org](http://plasticfreejuly.org) OR just take the action anyway and start creating new habits. Tell your family and friends that you are participating and encourage them to join you! More information will be on our Eco Church notice board soon.
