



From the Study
Habakkuk 3:19 (NIV)

***The Sovereign LORD is my strength;
he makes my feet like the feet of a deer,
he enables me to go on the heights.***

Is your hope and faith unquestionably in the Lord God?
Do you trust Him even in the midst of pain, poverty, sickness or
challenging relationships?
Habakkuk had witnessed many struggles among God's people,
many trials and tribulations, but he could conclude, even when all
was not right, 'yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God
my Saviour.' (v18)

The encouragement we can glean from Habakkuk is that no matter
what we encounter or endure God is still our faithful hope and
surety. In spite of our circumstances God gives us strength and He
enables those who put their trust in Him. The symbolism of the
deers' feet is that they are nimble and agile, even on steep
mountains. While God may not cure my fear of heights He will
enable me to climb spiritual heights to receive His blessings.

We have an awesome God who ministers to us even in our
struggles, as the Apostle Paul says:

***16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are
wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.
17 For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an
eternal glory that far outweighs them all. 18 So we fix our eyes not
on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is
temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. 'Salvation is found in no-
one else'. (2 Corinthians 4:16-18)***

Bra Bank


We understand that it's not easy to find affordable underwear, so we're here to help.





ECO-Matters

In case you're not aware, or as a reminder, (because I don't often see anyone reading anything on there,) our Church's Eco notice board is on the wall between the doors into the hall. Information is changed fairly regularly but there are some 'constant' things too – such as our framed Silver Eco Church award certificate and a copy of our Church's Ethical Purchasing Policy.

There is also an Eco Tips calendar, currently covering the first five months of the year and which points out various ideas for activities during each month.

January was all about the Big Garden Birdwatch which happened over the weekend of 23rd to 25th January. Did any of you take part? Last year, nearly 600,000 people took part and over nine million birds were counted. We've lost a staggering 38 million birds from UK skies in the last 60 years. With birds facing so many challenges, it's more important than ever to get involved in the Birdwatch.

So into February now and the focus is on a Carbon Fast. Climate Steward's Carbon Fast operates during Lent – a time when Christians traditionally fast and focus on God. The Carbon Fast will help you consider ways to live more simply, give you new ideas to cut your carbon footprint and invite you to focus on God and consider the whole of his creation.

Beginning on 5 March, if you sign up, you'll receive a weekly email containing key facts, suggestions for how you could reduce your carbon footprint and a prayer to lead you through this Lenten season. Each week features a different theme designed to help us take climate action in manageable ways that bear witness to a God who has promised to restore all of his creation. 
