



From the Study

Acts 20:24 (Complete Jewish Bible)

But I consider my own life of no importance to me whatsoever, as long as I can finish the course ahead of me, the task I received from the Lord Yeshua — to declare in depth the Good News of God's love and kindness.

How often do you share '*the Good News of God's love and kindness*'? As Christians we claim to love God, we promise to serve God, but how do we show either to those around us?

People often accuse Christians of being 'hypocrites', and perhaps for good reason, as we don't always practice what we preach, nor do we always understand what we claim to be true. Our narrative has changed over time as we focus on cultural issues, societal transitions, politics and other agendas, the result being that we drift away from the scriptures and the truth we claim to believe. For many people life just gets in the way so that God / Jesus no longer becomes the central focus of their lives.

Paul would say, "*But I consider my own life of no importance to me whatsoever*". It would be easy to build a doctrine of those words, however it would be wrong to do so as, 'a text out of context is a pretext.' Paul would go on to complete his statement, "*as long as I can finish the course ahead of me, the task I received from the Lord Yeshua*".

Far be it for me to tell anyone what to do with their lives, but it would be remiss of me not to point out that this present life cannot compare to the eternal-life Jesus paid for with His own blood and His life. There is a depth of Good News to be shared of an eternal, unchanging God who calls us to repent and worship and serve Him only, finishing the course He has set before us in the Lord Jesus.

Bra Bank


We understand that it's not easy to find affordable underwear, so we're here to help.





Looking back at the Fairtrade fortnight events: the chocolate tasting evening was well supported and all enjoyed. The stall with FT goods also well supported and around £52 worth was sold. So both these events further raising the profile of Fairtrade in the church. Thanks to those who supported.

We want to make more progress on our eco action plan this year, which as you should know covers 5 aspects of church life - Worship and teaching, Building and energy, Land and nature, Community and global engagement and Lifestyle. With regards to cleaning products, an eco friendly spray which meets the British Standards for hygiene in line with our kitchen hygiene rules has been in place for a few months now and so needs to be used on surfaces in the kitchen and servery areas.
