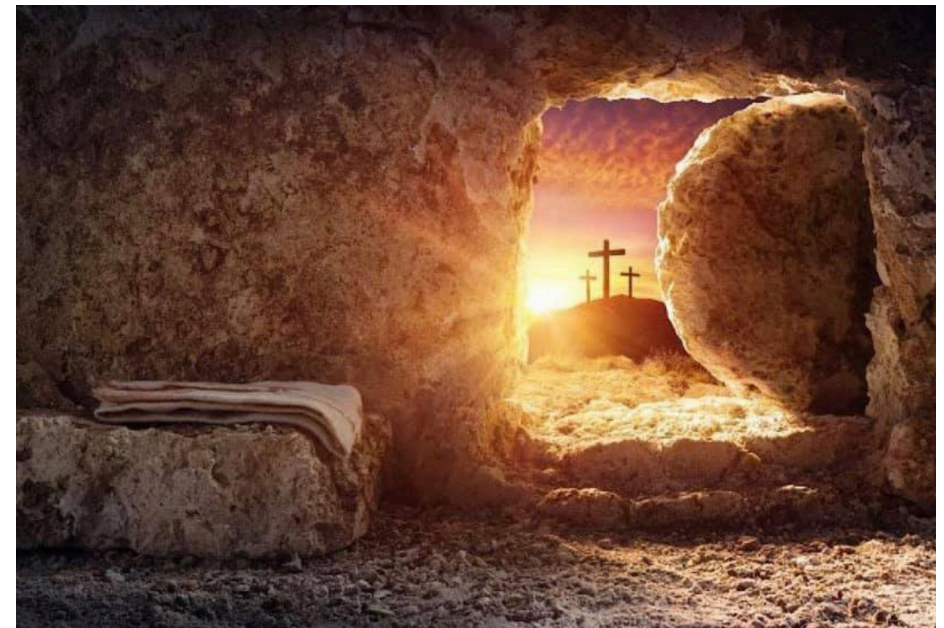

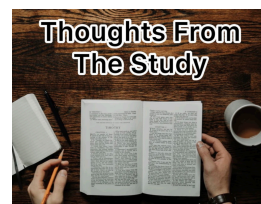

## *From the Study*

*Luke 23:34<sup>a</sup> (NIV-UK)*

*‘Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.”’*

As the Roman soldiers stripped Jesus naked and nailed Him to the cross they were unaware that they were involved in God’s greater plan of salvation; thus Jesus could say to the heavenly Father, “... *forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.*”

How often can we say that we don’t know what we are doing from a moral perspective. Someone may grow up in a household where crime and disorder, and disrespect is normal behaviour, how can such a person know right from wrong, or that he or she is a sinner?

Even Christians who have long standing in the church have faults, they commit sin often without even realising; even church leaders have all too often fallen at the hurdle of temptation, initially not even realising they were being tempted.

Sometimes our sin becomes so normal to us that we don’t even consider it to be sin, then we get into a lifestyle where the Son is replaced by sin, yet we still hope for salvation and heaven.

We need to learn to understand again that sin is always sin, salvation is only through Jesus who shed His blood to wash away the sin of the world (not to cover over it, but to wash it away).

But, for times when we don’t know we are sinning, David the Psalmist says:

*‘But who can discern their own errors?  
Forgive my hidden faults.’*

Be blessed and *be a blessing* this month in Jesus name,

*Pastor Phil.*

*Lord Jesus, keep us always in Your word.  
Thank You Lord, Amen.*

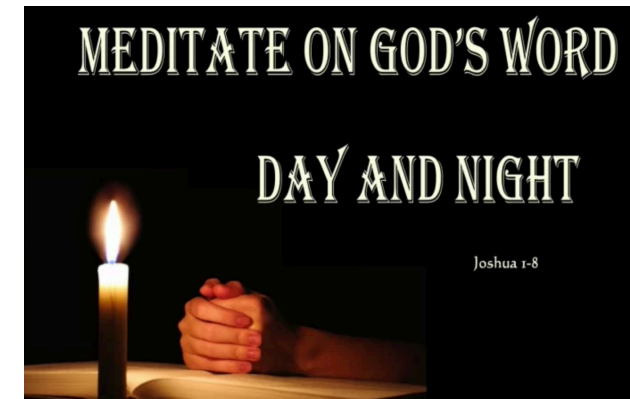

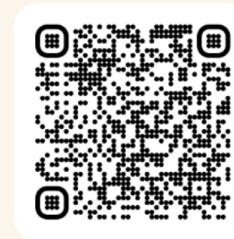
