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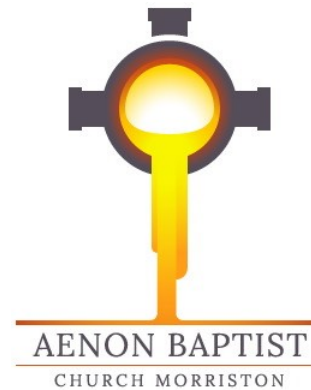

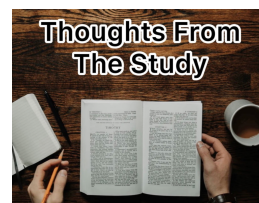

Psalm 56:4 (NIV-UK)

***‘In God, whose word I praise –
in God I trust and am not afraid.
What can mere mortals do to me?’***

I sometimes wonder how much we really do put our trust in God, in His word, how much of His word do we actually believe such that we act upon it or allow it to direct our lives.

I know, from experience and conversation over time, that many Christians don't even read the Bible, often making excuses about 'not having time'. How can anyone praise God's word if they don't read it, listen to it, meditate on it?

Some will claim they don't read the Bible but God speaks to them - but how do they know it's God speaking if they don't know His word? It is impossible for God to contradict His word, because to do so would make Him a liar, and the Holy Spirit cannot teach anything 'new', only what Jesus has first taught, and what is in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments.

When we are readers of God's word, believing the Holy Spirit teaches, then we will be encouraged to praise and trust God's word, never fearing the challenges of this world.

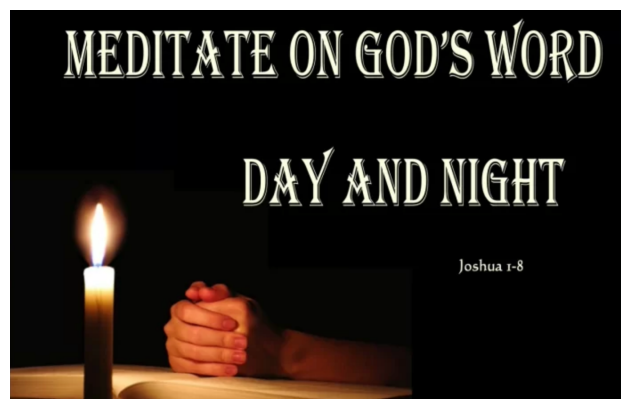

Churches Count on Nature

Churches Count on Nature (CCoN) is a joint initiative promoted by Caring for God's Acre, A Rocha UK, the Church in Wales and the Church of England, and is now in its 6th year!

It takes place between Saturday 6 June to Sunday 14 June and so there's just about enough time to arrange an activity or event in your churchyard or chapel yard that encourages spending time in nature. It can be small and just open to your own congregation or a larger event inviting community members. It is open to all denominations, but if you cannot organise your own event, then why not speak to another church and hold a joint event or simply go along to one already happening near you? Nearly 20 events are happening across Wales, and you can see more about the locations and any other information you need at <https://arocha.org.uk/events/> A series of free webinars will run all week, too and details can also be found on that page. Subjects include sharing stories to grow hope, making burial grounds a home for butterflies and one on lichens in churchyards as well as a more urban focus- on wildlife in towns and cities.
